All public school districts and county offices of education in California must use the FIT to determine if their school facilities are in "good repair" as defined in Education Code Section 17002 (1). The FIT is intended to aid in ensuring that all California school children have access to clean, safe, and functional school facilities. Intended as a visual inspection tool, fifteen components are evaluated as part of the FIT. Additionally, the FIT includes a rating system to evaluate each component, and ranks the overall condition of the school.
