Our Marcum-Illinois Families,

All districts in Sutter County have received notification from Dr. Luu of the County Health Department. A copy of the letter can be seen in the email sent to parents and on our website. 7th and 8th grade are mandated to go back to distance learning on November 23rd. 6th grade will also be on distance learning as the grade levels all share teachers. We are truly sorry for the situation based on the COVID case counts. Hopefully, we will see a drop in numbers so that are students can return soon.

For grades TK through 5th grade we will be continuing with on campus learning. Given the high case numbers, the probability that we may have to transition one or more grade level cohorts to distance learning is high. We will do our best to continue with in-person learning for as long as our health officials tell us it is safe.

Please know that if we close a grade level from in person learning, we will be unable to give out specific details other than we have a potential COVID case. If your child has had any direct contact with the case, you will be notified by contact tracers. HIPPA laws do not allow for us to give out specific information.

The safety of your child, and their opportunity to learn is our top priority. We will continue to provide the best instruction we can whether it is in person or online.
